MATERIALS

- Yarn of different colors: white, black, green, red, yellow, brown.

- -Thickness of the yarn: 3 mm.
- Hook according to the thickness of the yarn.
- Yarn needle.
- Fiberfill.

ABBREVIATIONS

sc: single crochet
st: stitch
ch: chain
inc: increase
dec: decrease
Fill the doll with fiberfill as you crochet

HEAD / BODY

With green yarn

1. Ch 19 and work 18 sc in the chains.

2. Continue without turning, in the beginning chains again but in the other side another 18 sc, to get a 36 sc in all (36).

3. Place the round marker to work around the piece 1 sc in each st (36).

4. to 6. 1 sc in each st (36).

7. 2 dec, 12 sc, 3 dec, 12 sc, 1 dec (30).

8. 2 dec, 9 sc, 3 dec, 9 sc, 1 dec (24).

9. 2 dec, 6 sc, 3 dec, 6 sc, 1 dec (18).

10. 2 inc, 6 sc, 3 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc (24).

11. 3 inc, 9 sc, 3 inc, 9 sc (30).

12. to 15. 1 sc in each st (30).

16. 2 sc, 3 dec, 9 sc, 3 dec, 7 sc (24).

17. 1 sc, 3 dec, 6 sc, 3 dec, 5 sc (18).

18. 3 dec, 3 sc, 3 dec, 3 sc (12).

19. 3 inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc (18).

20. 1 sc, 3 inc, 6 sc, 3 inc, 5 sc (24).

21. to 24. 1 sc in each st (24).

25. 3 sc, 3 dec, 6 sc, 3 dec, 3 sc (18).

26. 2 sc, 3 dec, 3 sc, 3 dec, 1 sc (12).

27. 1 sc in each st (12).

28. "2 sc, dec", repeat (9).

29. 1 sc in each st (9).

30. "1 sc, dec", repeat (6).

Fasten off. Sew the hole with the yarn needle



FEET (x2)

With brown yarn

- 1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
- 2. Inc in every st (12).
- 3. "1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
- 4. and 5. 1 sc in each st (18).
- 6. 3 dec, 12 sc (15).
- 7. 2 dec, 9 sc, 1 dec (12).
- 8. Dec in every st (6).
- 9. and 10. 1 sc in each st (6).

Fasten off.













ARMS (x2)

With red yarn


- 1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
- 2. Inc in every st (12).
- 3. to 5. 1 sc in each st (12).
- 6. Dec in every st (6).

7. Change to green yarn and work in back loops only 1 sc in each st. You will return to this round to complete the arms (6).

8. to 11. 1 sc in each st (6).

Fasten off.





COMPLETE THE ARMS

With white yarn

Return to round 7 of the arm and holding it with the hand of the doll pointing down, work in the free loops inc in every st (12).

Fasten off.

EYES (x2)

Background

With white yarn1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.2. Inc in every st (12).Fasten off.


Pupil

With black yarn1. Work 4 sc in magic ring.2. Inc in every st (8).Fasten off.

Twinkle

With white yarn Work 4 sc in magic ring. Fasten off.

Sew the pupil to one side of the white background and sew the twinkle over it.







STAR

With yellow yarn

1. Work 15 sc in magic ring.

2. "1 slip st in the first st, 1 **bobble st*** made by 3 double crochet on the next stitch, 1 sc in the same st, 1 slip st in the next st" Repeat around the round to have the 5 points of the star.

***Bobble st** consists of making 3 double crochet on the same stitch, removing 2 loops from the hook in each of them until finally having 4 loops on the hook that you close with 1 sc and 1 chain.

Fasten off.

SNOWFLAKE GARLAND

With white yarn


1. Ch 97.

2. [1 slip st and in that same st work "ch 3, 1 slip st" 3 times, 1 slip st in the next st, 1 slip st in the next st] Turn the piece and repeat the sequence between [] working in the chains to the end.

You will have crocheted 32 snowflakes.

The fact of turning the piece after each sequence is due to the fact that each snowflake is crocheted to one side and when it comes to attaching the garland to the tree, it gives it movement.

Fasten off



ASSEMBLY

Sew the **eyes** leaving 2 sc of separation from the lower narrow part of the top area, that is, on round 16. Leave 4 sc of separation between them on that round

In line in relation to the final part of the eyes, centered between them, embroider the **mouth** with black yarn, with a length of 3 sc. On it embroider a fine white line as **teeth**.


Sew the **arms** leaving 2 sc of separation from the lower narrow part of the central area, that is, on round 8.

Sew the **feet** over the beginning rows of the piece, leaving approximately 6 sc of separation from the ends.

Sew the **star** in the top of the tree. Do it in the area between the 2 points that you will place at the bottom.

Sew the **garland** around the body as seen in the images. Do it along the row of chains, leaving the snowflakes loose and trying to keep some facing up and others facing down, to give movement to the garland.
