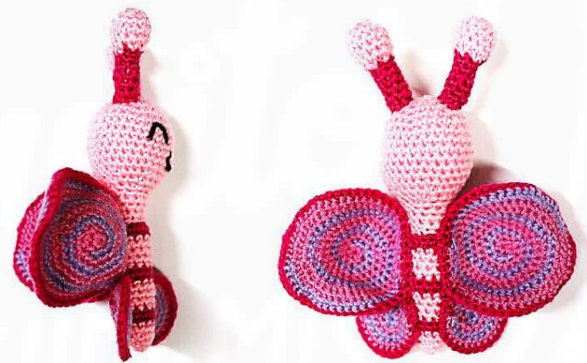
Size: 5,9 " / 15 cm
Difficulty: Low
Estimated time: 6 h
Hook size: 2-3 mm

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MATERIALS

- Yarn of different colors: black, light pink, pink, fuchsia, lilac.
- Yarn thickness: 3 mm.
- Crochet needle according to the size of the yarn.
- Yarn needle.
- Fiberfill.

ABBREVIATIONS

sc: single crochet

st: stitch

inc: increase

dec: decrease

Fill the doll with fiberfill as you crochet.

HEAD / BODY

With light pink yarn

1. Work 6 sc in a magic ring.
2. Inc in all st (12).
3. "1 sc, inc", repeat to the end of the round (18).
4. "2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
5. "3 sc, inc", repeat (30).
6. to 12. 1 sc in each st (30).
13. "3 sc, dec", repeat (24).
14. "2 sc, dec", repeat (18).
15. "1 sc, dec", repeat (12).
16. to 19. 1 sc in each st (12).
20. Change to fuchsia yarn and crochet 1 sc in each st (12).
21. 1 sc in each st (12).
22. Change to light pink yarn and crochet 1 sc in each st (12).
23. to 25. 1 sc in each st (12).
26. Change to fuchsia yarn and crochet 1 sc in each st (12).
27. 1 sc in each st (12).
28. Change to light pink yarn and crochet 1 sc in each st (12).
29. to 31. 1 sc in each st (12).
32. Change to fuchsia yarn and crochet 1 sc in each st (12).
33. 1 sc in each st (12).
34. Change to light pink yarn and crochet 1 sc in each st (12).
35. 1 sc in each st (12).



36. "2 sc, dec", repeat (9).

37. "1 sc, dec", repeat (6).

Fasten off.

Sew the hole with the yarn needle.



To crochet the wings and the color change look good on both sides we will use the technique of reversible color change.

WINGS (x2)

Big (x2)

With pink yarn

You must make the color changes keeping the 2 threads in the fabric so that the piece is reversible.

1. Work 6 sc in a magic ring.
2. 3 inc. Change to lilac yarn and crochet 3 inc (12).
3. "1 sc, inc" 2 times. Change to pink yarn and crochet "1 sc, inc" 4 times (18).
4. "2 sc, inc" 2 times. Change to lilac yarn and crochet "2 sc, inc" 3 times. Change to pink yarn and crochet 2 sc, 1 inc (24).
5. "3 sc, inc" 5 times. Change to lilac yarn and crochet "3 sc, inc" 1 time (30).
6. "4 sc, inc" 2 times. Change to pink yarn and crochet "4 sc, inc" 4 times (36).
7. "3 sc, inc" 3 times. Change to lilac yarn and crochet "3 sc, inc" 3 times, 6 sc. Change to pink yarn and crochet 6 sc (42).
8. 9 sc, "1 sc, inc" 6 times, 15 sc. Change to lilac yarn and crochet 6 sc (48).
9. 9 sc, "2 sc, inc" 3 times. Change to pink yarn and crochet "2 sc, inc" 3 times, 9 sc, "2 sc, dec" 3 times (51).
10. Change to fuchsia yarn and crochet 1 sc in each st (51).

Fasten off.

You must conceal the threads that you have in the back of the piece introducing them carefully between the fabric.



Small (x2)

With lilac yarn

1. Work 6 sc in a magic ring.
 2. Change to pink yarn and crochet Inc in all st (12).
 3. Change to lilac yarn and crochet "1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
 4. Change to pink yarn and crochet "2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
 5. Change to fuchsia yarn and crochet 1 sc in each st (24).
- Fasten off.



ANTENNAS (x2)

With light pink yarn

1. Work 6 sc in a magic ring.
 2. Inc in all st (12).
 3. to 5. 1 sc in each st (12).
 6. Change to fuchsia yarn and crochet Dec in all st (6).
 7. to 12. 1 sc in each st (6).
- Fasten off.



ASSEMBLY

Wings:

Sew the big ones from round 17 to round 27, joining to the body the part in which you have made the decreases of round 9. They will remain with volume.

Sew the small ones in front of the big ones from round 29 to round 34.

Antennas:

On both sides of the initial magic ring, leaving 1 sc of separation from this one.

Eyes and Mouth:

Embroider the eyes with black yarn between rounds 6 and 7 until round 8 of the head. Leave 2 sc of separation between the ends.

Embroider the mouth centered under the eyes, between the rows 9 and 10 until round 12, leaving also 2 sc of separation between the ends.
