## HEAD

With white yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. 1 sc in each st (6).
3. "1 sc, inc", repeat (9).
4. 1 sc in each st (9).
5. "2 sc, inc", repeat (12).
6. 1 sc in each st (12).
7. "1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
8. 1 sc in each st (18).
9. "2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
10. 1 sc in each st (24).
11. "3 sc, inc", repeat (30).
12. 1 sc in each st (30).
13. "4 sc, inc", repeat (36).
14. 1 sc in each st (36).
15. " 5 sc, inc", repeat (42).
16. 1 sc in each st (42).
17. " 6 sc, inc", repeat (48).
18. 1 sc in each st (48).
19. "7 sc, inc", repeat (54).
20. 1 sc in each st (54).
21. "8 sc, inc", repeat (60).
22. and 23. 1 sc in each st (60).


Divide the piece in half from where you are by counting 30 sc to the left:

1. Work 29 sc on the segment which, together with the mark stitch, make 30 sc in all (30).
2. to 7. Don't ch 1, turn, work 1 sc in each st until you reach the last 2 stitches, then dec 1 (28), (26), (24), (22), (20), (18).
3. Place the round marker to work around the piece with sc: $7 \mathrm{sc}+30 \mathrm{sc}+7 \mathrm{sc}+18 \mathrm{sc}=62$ sc.
4. Work 1 sc in the post of each st (62).

Fasten off.


## SNOUT

With light pink yarn

1. Ch 13 and work 12 sc on the chains.
2. Continue without turning, on the beginning chains again but in the other side another 12 sc to get a 24 sc piece in all (24).
3. Place the round marker to start working in
rounds "3 sc, inc", repeat (30).
4. "4 sc, inc", repeat (36).
5. 1 sc in each st (36).
6. " $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}$ ", repeat (42).
7. 1 sc in each st (42).


8. Change to black yarn and work in back loops only with slip stitches 1 inc in each st (84).

Fasten off.

NOSE HOLES (x2)
With light pink yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. Inc in every st (12).
3. Change to black yarn and work in back loops only with slip stitches 1 st in each st (12).

Fasten off.


## EARS (x2)

## Outer part

With white yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. 1 sc in each st (6).
3. " 1 sc, inc", repeat (9).
4. "2 sc, inc", repeat (12).
5. "3 sc, inc", repeat (15).
6. "4 sc, inc", repeat (18).
7. 1 sc in each st (18).
8. "4 sc, dec", repeat (15).
9. "3 sc, dec", repeat (12).

Fasten off

## Inner Part

With light pink yarn

1. Ch 5 and work 4 sc on the chains.
2. to 4. Don't ch 1 , turn and work 1 sc in each st (3), (2), (1).
3. Place the round marker to work around the piece with sc: $4 \mathrm{sc}+4 \mathrm{sc}+4 \mathrm{sc}+1 \mathrm{sc}=13 \mathrm{sc}$.
4. Change to black yarn and work in back loops only 1 slip st in each st (13).

Fasten off.
Sew the inner part centered on the outer part


## HORNS (x2)

With light yellow yarn

1. Work 4 sc in magic ring.
2."1 sc, inc", repeat (6).
2. 1 sc in each st (6).
4."1 sc, inc", repeat (9).
3. 1 sc in each st (9).
6."2 sc, inc", repeat (12).
4. 1 sc in each st (12).

Fasten off.


## EYES (x2)

With black yarn

1. Ch 7 and work 6 slip stitches on the chains.
2. Change to white yarn and continue without turning, on the beginning chains again but in the other side another 6 slip stitches to get a 12 slip stitches piece in all (12).

Fasten off.

2. to 4. Don't ch 1 , turn and work 1 sc in each st until you reach the last 2 stitches, then dec 1. (6), (4), (2).
5. Place the round marker to work around the piece with sc: $4 \mathrm{sc}+8 \mathrm{sc}+4 \mathrm{sc}+2 \mathrm{sc}$.

Fasten off.


## ASSEMBLY

Sew the snout close to the bottom of the longer side of the head. Make sure to center it in relation to the pointed part beginning of it.

Sew the nose holes on the snout. Do it on the second row counting from the top and leaving 6 sc between them on that same line.

Attached to the pointed part of the head, sew the horns and then the ears to which you will have already added the inner part centered.

In line with respect to the nose holes and leaving 3 st of separation from the snout, sew the eyes slightly curved. Place the white line facing up, but when sewing them, embroider a thin black line on top.

Finally sew the spots, one with the longest part between the ear and the horn and the other attached to the left edge of the head.
