## WOODY WOODPECKER Amigurumi Pattern



Size: $\quad 16,9$ " / 43 cm
Difficulty: High
Estimated time: 12 h
Hook size: $\quad 2-3 \mathrm{~mm}$

## MATERIALS

- Yarn of different colors: white, black, yellow, blue, red, light green.
, Thickness of the yarn: 3-4 mm.
- Hook according to the thickness of the yarn.

Yarn needle.
Fiberfill.

## ABBREVIATIONS

sc: single crochet
st: stitch
ch: chain
inc: increase
dec: decrease

Fill the doll with fiberfill as you crochet.

## LEGS (x2)

With blue yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. Inc in every st (12).
3. " 1 sc , inc", repeat to the end of the round (18).
4. 1 sc in each st (18).
5. Crochet in back loops only 1 sc in each st (18). You will return to this round to sew the feet in the free loops.
6. and 7.1 sc in each st (18).
7. "2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
8. To 12.1 sc in each st (24).
9. "3 sc, inc", repeat (30).
10. To 16.1 sc in each st (30).

Fasten off the first leg. Follow the pattern to make the second leg and do not fasten off to join both legs.

## Joining legs:

Place one leg next to the other leg; mark the center point between legs. Crochet in the leg that is not fastened off 1 sc in each st until you get the marker. Join the first leg with a sc, then sc in each st until you reach the marker and join the second leg with a sc.

Sew the hole between the legs closed with the yarn needle.
Continue crocheting the BODY:


## BODY

1. You will have 60 sc .
2. " $8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ", repeat (54).
3. "7 sc, dec", repeat (48).
4. 1 sc in each st (48).
5. Divide the piece into 2 equal parts of 24 sc each one (front and back) to begin crocheting the buttocks. Mark the back segment of 24 sc and crochet " 3 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (54). After crocheting on the back segment, continue marking the beginning
 and end of it, as this will guide you in future rounds. Move the round marker that you place to locate the beginning of each round in a normal way, without influencing the division.
6. Now the back segment has 30 sc and on them crochet " 4 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round, thus maintaining unchanged the front segment. (60) Mark once again the back segment that now, after the increases already has 36 sc.
7. To 12.1 sc in each st (60). Don't move the marks that you have left in round 6 .
8. Use the marks as a guide and divide the body again in 2 parts (the back segment with 36 sc and the front segment unchanged with 24 sc ). ATTENTION: You still do not have to remove the marks of round 6 .


It is about reducing the buttocks, for which you will crochet on the back segment " 4 sc , dec" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round. (54). Continue marking the segment.
14. Now the back segment has 30 sc . In this round you will equal both. For this, crochet " 3 sc , dec" 6 times in the back segment and 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (48). On this occasion it is not necessary to mark the segment, as the marks that will guide you in the future rounds will be those that you left on round 6 .
15. and 16.1 sc in each st (48).
17. In this round you will have to guide yourself again by the marks of round 6 to once again divide the body into 2 equal parts of 24 sc each, and be able to increase the belly, that is, the front segment. Thus, once this segment is marked, crochet on it " 3 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st on the rest of the round (54).
18. to 25.1 sc in each st (54).
26. "7 sc, dec", repeat (48).
27. To 30. 1 sc in each st (48).
31. " $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ", repeat (42).
32. To 35.1 sc in each st (42).
36. " 5 sc , dec", repeat (36).
37. To 40. 1 sc in each st (36).
41. "4 sc, dec", repeat (30).
42. To 45.1 sc in each st (30).
46. "3 sc, dec", repeat (24).

47. Change to red yarn and crochet in back loops only 1 sc in each st (24). You will return to this round to complete the collar.
48. To 60.1 sc in each st (24).

Fasten off.

## ARMS (x2)

With white yarn

## Thumb :

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. To 4.1 sc in each st (6).

Fasten off.

## Fingers (x3):

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. To 5.1 sc in each st (6).

Fasten off.
Crochet 2 fingers and fasten off, leave the third finger without fastening off to start Joining the Fingers:

1. Work 1 sc in the next finger and then 2 sc , work 1 sc in the third finger and then 5 sc .

Repeat the same sequence on the other side. You will end with 18 st. ( 3 fingers $\times 6$ sc). (18).
2. To 6. 1 sc in each st (18).
7. " 1 sc , dec", repeat (12).
8. 1 sc in each st (12).
9. "2 sc, dec", repeat (9).
10. Change to blue yarn and crochet in back loops only 1 sc in each st (9). You will return to this round to complete the hand.
11.1 sc in each st (9).
12. " 2 sc , inc", repeat (12).
13. To 15.1 sc in each st (12).
16. " 3 sc , inc", repeat (15).
17. To 25.1 sc in each st (15).

26. " 4 sc , inc", repeat (18).
27. To 38.1 sc in each st (18).
39. "1 sc, dec", repeat (12).
40. Dec in every st (6).

Fasten off. Sew the hole with the yarn needle.

## COMPLETE THE HANDS

With white yarn

1. Return to round 10 of the arms and holding the doll with the hands pointing down, crochet in the free loops " 2 sc, inc", repeat (12).
2. "1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
3. "2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
4. 1 sc in each st (24).
5. Dec in every st (12).

Fasten off. Fold.

## COMPLETE THE NECK

With white yarn

1. Return to round 47 of the body and holding the doll with the feet pointing up, divide the 24 sc of the round into 2 equal parts of 12 sc each, marking the beginning and end of the division (front and back).

Crochet in the free loops, starting in the right side, joining in the previous st to the dividing mark, in which you will place the round marker.


By this way, you will start crocheting in the front segment " 1 sc, inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (30).
2. " 2 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (36).
3. " 3 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (42).
4. " 4 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (48).
5. " 5 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (54).
6. " 6 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (60).
7. " 7 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (66).
8. " 8 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (72).
9. "9 sc, inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (78).
10. " 10 sc , inc" 6 times, 1 sc in each st in the rest of the round (84).
11. To 15.1 sc in each st (84).
16. Dec in every st (42).
17. " 5 sc , dec", repeat (36).
18. "4 sc, dec", repeat (30).
19. "3 sc, dec", repeat (24).

Fasten off.
Fold the fabric and sew to the round 47, that is, to the round in which you began to crochet the neck. Stuff partially before completing the closure, so that it has body but is not too bulky.



## FEET (x2)

With yellow yarn

## Toes (x2):

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. Inc in every st (12)
3. To 6.1 sc in each st (12).

Fasten off.
Crochet 1 toe and fasten off, leave the second toe without fastening off to start Joining the toes:

1. Work 1 sc in the other toe and then 11 sc . Repeat the same sequence on the other side. You will end with 24 st. ( 2 toes $\times 12 \mathrm{sc}$ ). (24). Sew the hole between the toes with the yarn needle.
2. "3 sc, inc", repeat (30).
3. To 5.1 sc in each st (30).
4. "3 sc, dec", repeat (24).
5. To 10.1 sc in each st (24).

6. "2 sc, dec", repeat (18).
7. To 15.1 sc in each st (18).
8. "1 sc, dec", repeat (12).
9. Dec in every st (6).

Fasten off.
Sew the hole with the yarn needle.

## HEAD

With red yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. Inc in every st (12).
3. "1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
4. "2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
5. "3 sc, inc", repeat (30).
6. "4 sc, inc", repeat (36).
7. " 5 sc, inc", repeat (42).
8. "6 sc, inc", repeat (48).
9. "7 sc, inc", repeat (54).
10. " 8 sc , inc", repeat (60).
11. To 25.1 sc in each st (60).
12. "8 sc, dec", repeat (54).
13. 1 sc in each st (54).
14. " 7 sc , dec", repeat (48).
15. 1 sc in each st (48).
16. "6 sc, dec", repeat (42).
17. 1 sc in each st (42).
18. " 5 sc , dec", repeat (36).
19. 1 sc in each st (36).
20. "4 sc, dec", repeat (30).
21. 1 sc in each st (30).

22. "3 sc, dec", repeat (24).
23. 1 sc in each st (24).

Fasten off.

## BEAK

## Top:

With yellow yarn

1. Work 4 sc in magic ring.
2. 1 sc in each st (4).
3. "1 sc, inc", repeat (6).
4. 1 sc in each st (6).
5. "1 sc, inc", repeat (9).
6.1 sc in each st (9).
6. "2 sc, inc", repeat (12).
8.1 sc in each st (12).
7. "1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
8. and 11.1 sc in each st (18).
9. "2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
10. and 14.1 sc in each st (24).
11. "3 sc, inc", repeat (30).
12. and 17.1 sc in each st (30).
13. " 4 sc , inc", repeat (36).
14. and 20.1 sc in each st (36).
15. " 5 sc, inc", repeat (42).
16. and 23.1 sc in each st (42).
17. " 6 sc , inc", repeat (48).

25 . and 26.1 sc in each st (48).
27. "7 sc, inc", repeat (54).
28. and 29.1 sc in each st (54).

30. " 8 sc, inc", repeat (60).

Fasten off.

## Bottom:

With yellow yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. Inc in every st (12).
3. and 4. 1 sc in each st (12).
4. "1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
5. 1 sc in each st (18).
6. "2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
7. 1 sc in each st (24).
8. "3 sc, inc", repeat (30).
9. 1 sc in each st (30).
10. " 4 sc , inc", repeat (36).
11. 1 sc in each st (36).
12. " 5 sc, inc", repeat (42).
13. 1 sc in each st (42).
14. " 6 sc , inc", repeat (48).
15. 1 sc in each st (48).
16. "7 sc, inc", repeat (54).
17. 1 sc in each st (54).
18. " 8 sc , inc", repeat (60).
19. 1 sc in each st (60).

Fasten off.


## Inside part of the mouth:

With black yarn

1. Ch 15, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in remaining 13 chains (14).
2. To 13. Don't ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each st (13), (12), (11), (10), (9), (8), (7), (6), (5), (4), (3), (2).
3. Place the round marker to start crocheting in rounds with sc. You will have: ( $13 \mathrm{sc}+14 \mathrm{sc}+13 \mathrm{sc}+2 \mathrm{sc}$ )

## Tongue:

With red yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. Inc in every st (12).
3. "1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
4. To 6. 1 sc in each st (18).
5. "1 sc, dec", repeat (12).
6. To 12.1 sc in each st (12).
7. Dec in every st (6).

Fasten off.

## Cheeks (x2):

With yellow yarn

1. Ch 11, turn, sc in 2 nd ch from hook, sc in remaining 9 chains (10).
2. To 7. Don't ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each st (9), (8), (7), (6), (5), (4).
3. Place the round marker to start crocheting in rounds with sc. You will have: ( $8 \mathrm{sc}+10 \mathrm{sc}+8 \mathrm{sc}+4 \mathrm{sc}$ ).

Fasten off. Stuff before completing the join with the face.


## Assembly:

Place the Top part from round 17 of the head, sinking in the front on both sides to leave the hole of the eyes.

Put it in its place, but you still can not begin to sew it.
Before putting the bottom piece, place the lower part of the piece from round 30. Do it in a curved way, so that the sides match with those of the top, in the area where you will place the cheeks.

In order to fit together both pieces, you must partially insert the top part of the bottom piece into the top piece.

Now you can start sewing both pieces to the face and each other.
Place the cheeks on both sides, with the narrow part out. Stuff them before completing the closing.

You only need to complete the mouth, sewing to the bottom piece both the black background and the tongue. Embroider on it a small line with black yarn.




## EYES (x2)

With white yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. " $1 \mathrm{inc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ " 2 times (8).
3. " $2 \mathrm{inc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ " 2 times (12).
4. 1 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 2 sc (18)
5. 2 sc, " 1 sc, inc" 3 times, 3 sc, " 1 sc, inc" 3 times, 1 sc (24).
6. 1 sc in each st (24).

Fasten off.

With light green yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. " $1 \mathrm{inc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ " 2 times (8).
3. " 2 inc, 2 sc" 2 times (12).
4. $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{inc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{inc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ (18)

Fasten off.

With black yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. " 1 inc, 2 sc" 2 times (8).
3. 1 sc in each st (8).

Fasten off.
Sew the eyes in the hole that you have left in the beak.

With white yarn embroider the twinkle and with black yarn embroider the pupil and the eye. Embroider over them the eyebrows with black yarn.


## HAIR

You have to divide it into 3 parts that you will join in the same way that you have joined the fingers of the hand or the foot.

## Big Tuft:

With red yarn

1. Work 4 sc in magic ring.
2. 1 sc in each st (4).
3. "1 sc, inc", repeat (6).
4. 1 sc in each st (6).
5. "1 sc, inc", repeat (9).
6. and 7.1 sc in each st (9).
7. "2 sc, inc", repeat (12).
8. and 10. 1 sc in each st (12).
11.3 dec, " 1 sc , inc" 3 times (12).
9. 2 dec, $2 \mathrm{sc}, " 1 \mathrm{sc}$, inc" 2 times, 2 sc (12).
10. 1 sc in each st (12).
11. "1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
12. To 18.1 sc in each st (18).
13. 2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
14. To 23.1 sc in each st (24).
15. 2 dec, " 1 sc, inc" 6 times, 4 dec (24).
16. 1 dec, " 5 sc , inc" 3 times, 2 dec (24).
17. To 29.1 sc in each st (24).
18. 3 dec, " 3 sc , inc" 4 times, 1 dec (24).
19. 2 dec, " 5 sc, inc" 3 times, 1 dec (24).
20. "3 sc, inc", repeat (30).
21. To 36. 1 sc in each st (30).

Fasten off.


## Medium Tuft:

## With red yarn

1. Work 4 sc in magic ring.
2. 1 sc in each st (4).
3. " 1 sc, inc", repeat (6).
4. and 5.1 sc in each st (6).
5. "1 sc, inc", repeat (9).
6. To 10.1 sc in each st (9).
7. "2 sc, inc", repeat (12).
8. To 15.1 sc in each st (12).
9. 3 dec, " 1 sc , inc" 3 times (12).
10. 2 dec, 2 sc, " 1 sc, inc" 2 times, 2 sc (12).
11. 1 sc in each st (12).
12. " 1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
13. To 22. 1 sc in each st (18).
14. "2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
15. and 25.1 sc in each st (24).
16. "3 sc, inc", repeat (30).

Fasten off.

## Small Tuft:

With red yarn

1. Work 4 sc in magic ring.
2. 1 sc in each st (4).
3. "1 sc, inc", repeat (6).
4. and 5.1 sc in each st (6).
5. "1 sc, inc", repeat (9).
6. and 8.1 sc in each st (9).
7. "2 sc, inc", repeat (12).
8. To 12.1 sc in each st (12).

Leave the last piece without fastening off to start Joining the pieces:

You must crochet with the tips of the pieces pointing down, placing them in the position shown in the image.

1. Work 1 sc in the medium piece and then 14 sc. Work 1 sc in the big piece and then 29 sc. Now you are in the other side so you must repeat working 1 sc in the medium piece and then 14 sc . Finally work 12 sc in the small piece completing the join. You will have 72 sc .
2. "10 sc, dec", repeat (66).
3. "9 sc, dec", repeat (60).
4. "8 sc, dec", repeat (54).
5. "7 sc, dec", repeat (48).
6. " 6 sc , dec", repeat (42).
7. " 5 sc, dec", repeat (36).
8. To 15.1 sc in each st (36).

Fasten off.
At the time of sewing at the head, you must also join on the forehead part of the biggest tuft. In addition you will sew the lower part of the medium tuft and the big one.



## BODY SPOT

With white yarn

1. Ch 7 turn, sc in 2 nd ch from hook, sc in remaining 5 chains (6).
2. In this row and the next ones, you will increase 2 sc . For this, you will Ch 2 before turning (one for increase and the other of separation). Crochet 1 sc in each st and inc 1 in the last sc (8).
3. and 4. Increase in the same way: Ch $2+$ final inc (10), (12).
4. To 30. Ch 1, turn and crochet 1 sc in each st (12).
5. To 33. In this row and the next ones, you will decrease 2 sc . For this, don't ch 1, turn, crochet 1 sc in each st and dec with the last 2 sc. (10), (8), (6).
6. Place the round marker to start crocheting in rounds with sc.


## TAIL (x2)

With blue yarn

1. Work 6 sc in magic ring.
2. Inc in every st (12).
3. "1 sc, inc", repeat (18).
4. "2 sc, inc", repeat (24).
5. and 6. 1 sc in each st (24).
6. "1 sc, dec" 2 times, 6 sc, " 1 sc, dec" 2 times, 6 sc (20).
7. "1 sc, dec" 2 times, 4 sc, " 1 sc, dec" 2 times, 4 sc (16).
8. To 14.1 sc in each st (16).
9. $2 \mathrm{sc}, " 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ " 2 times, $2 \mathrm{sc}, " 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec" 2 times (12).
10. To 25.1 sc in each st (12).
11. "2 sc, dec", repeat (9).
12. To 35.1 sc in each st (9).

## Fasten off.

When stuffing the piece, try to crush it so that it is as flat as possible. To achieve this, the part where you have made the decreases must be placed on the sides.
